NZARES One Day in-person Symposium 2023

Location: Massey University, Palmerston North Campus **Date**: 21 November 2023

We are pleased to announce that NZARES is hosting a one-day in-person symposium on November 21, 2023. The theme of the Symposium is the Economic Resilience of New Zealand's Global Value Chains. The day-long event will be split into two separate sessions. The morning session will comprise a panel discussion from government and policymakers, researchers, and participants in global value chains to discuss the different perspectives on the interconnectedness between the resilience of these global value chains and New Zealand's economic development.

The afternoon session will include two consecutive in-person single-stream contributed paper sessions focusing on research being undertaken by research organisations into the resilience of global value chains. This can include universities, CRI, and industry. Each accepted paper will be allocated 20 minutes for presentation, followed by 5 minutes of questions and discussion. Due to time constraints in the afternoon session, the number of papers is limited to 6.

The organising committee cordially invites interested participants and scholars for the contributed paper sessions to submit their extended abstracts to nzares@nzares.org.nz by October 23, 2023, at 5:00 PM NZST. Authors will be informed about the acceptance of their submission by November 1, 2023.
